HIERARCHY	POLICE REMUNERATION REVIEW BODY Provides independent advice to the Government on pay and conditions for police officers at or below the rank of chief superintendent.	POLICE PENSIONS SCHEME ADVISORY BOARD (SAB) Provides advice, on request, to the Secretary of State for the Home Department on the desirability of changes to the police pension schemes. Provides advice, on request or otherwise, to police pension scheme managers and pension boards in relation to the effective and efficient administration and management of the police pension scheme 2015 and any statutory pension scheme that is connected with it.	POLICE ADVISORY BOARD OF ENGLAND & WALES (PAB) Considers draft regulations under the Police Act 1996 about matters such as recruitment, diversity and collaboration between forces. It also works with police managers and staff to respond to more general questions from the Home Secretary about changes to and reform of the police.
	POLICE CONSULTATIVE FORUM (PCF) Facilitates understanding of one another's (employers' representatives and staff associations) priorities, enables the sharing of perspectives on relevant issues, allows for co-operative resolution of difficulties, and minimises the risk of escalation of disputes.	UK POLICE PENSIONS CONSULTATIVE FORUM Subsumed into the Scheme Advisory Board, facilitated as one meeting with two agendas, to cover Scotland and Northern Ireland.	COLLEGE OF POLICING PROFESSIONAL COMMITTEE A committee of the College's Board of Directors, it has delegated authority from the Board and oversees national standard setting for the police profession.
